

Skater Recognition Awards will be presented for the first time in 2018.

- Most U.S. Figure Skating tests passed between July 1, 2017, and the time of our annual skater recognition dinner
- Most Basic Skills levels passed starting with the first fall Learn-To-Skate session (August 24 - October 15) through the time of our annual skater recognition dinner. Recognition winner must be a club member.
- Highest number of points for medals earned in competitive events between July 1, 2017, and the time of our annual skater recognition dinner. (5 points for gold, 3 points for silver, 1 point for bronze.)

Two additional awards that depend on circumstances each season:

- The “Get Up” Award, for a club member who had to overcome a significant challenge during the season. The circumstances may or may not directly involve skating. You’re encouraged to nominate individuals for this award. We will provide a nomination form. The board will review nominations and select a winner or winners.
- The “Above and Beyond” Award, presented to an individual or organization who has made a significant contribution to the club’s success. The club’s board of directors will select the recipient of this award.
